PART A: ACTION TAKEN ON THE MINUTES

1. Curriculum Revision

The syllabus of R2018 was finalized during board of studies meeting which comprises of academic experts, industrial experts and alumni. After several brainstorming sessions, the syllabus for the 2018-2019 academic year was updated with the industrial requirements.

2. Academic Audit

An internal academic audit was conducted to ensure the standards in the teaching learning process. The heads of various departments audited the documents of other departments and suggested procedures to overcome the short comings.

3. Faculty Review

As per the guidelines of the committee members, Faculty review was conducted in the month of may to review the performance of faculty and set benchmarks for performance. The academic performances of all the faculty members were evaluated. All the faculty members were instructed to produce above 95 % results. All the doctorates were instructed to publish in a Web of science journal and SCOPUS journal. All the non doctorates were instructed to publish in atleast one scopus journals.

1.SWAYAM NPTEL STATUS

As per the committee member suggestions, a total of 1333 students registered for NPTEL exam in the current academic year across all the departments. The progresses of the students are monitored and they are motivated to secure elite category in the final exam.

2. Internal test review

Based on the results of the CIA I, an academic audit was conducted on 24 august 2018. Faculty members were advised to take class notes from NPTEL materials. They were also motivated to give above 95 percentage results.

3. AICTE Curriculum implementation

The updated curriculum was implemented and followed by the first year students from the month of august.

1.Follow up of target plans for 2018-2019

A total of 132 research work has been published so far in the international journals for the academic year 2018-2019.

3.SIH

1. SWAYAM NPTEL STATUS

As per the committee members suggestions, the students were motivated to participate in NPTEL exams. The results of the July- October NPTEL are released. The institution ranks 11 among the top 100 institutions across india. Among 1333 students, 1287 students have attended and 1157 students are certified. 11 students completed the certification with Gold category and 557 students completed with elite category. 23 students are toppers of their course. All the students certified are congratulated by the principal and hods. They are motivated to study more courses

2. AICTE CII SURVEY

The institution is participating in AICTE - CII Survey of Industry-Linked Technical Institutes category. The details of student's participation in industrial visit, internship, seminars handled by the industrial experts, faculty trained by the industry and faculty providing training to the industrial experts are submitted to the AICTE .

3.SIH Status

As per the committee member's suggestions, 263 teams are motivated to provide solutions for the 1060 problems posted by the 27 union ministries and 17 state ministries of Government of India and leading industries. An internal brainstorming session is conducted and students are motivated to come up with innovative solutions. The feasibility study on the projects are analyzed and suggestions are given by the senior faculty members

4.NIRF status

1. NIRF RANK OF INSTITUTION

The institution has successfully submitted all the details for the NIRF ranking and awaiting results. The institution is confident of being ranked in top positions.

2. SIH Award Status

The institution was selected as one of the 48 nodal centres across India to solve real time 334 problems posted by 17 Union Ministries and 75 industries on 1st and 2nd March, 2019. The institution had been selected as the nodal centre for solving the problems of industries viz TVS motors, Griffi technologies, Appollo hospitals and India Health. Ten teams were mentored for participating in the grand finale of SIH during the year 2019. Four mentored teams have won First prizes worth 3.75 Lakhs at SIH 2019

- **Conducting national level hackathons**

Smart india hackathon 2019 was organized in our institute on 1st and 2nd March, 2019. SKCET is one of the chosen 48 nodal centres for conducting this event. It is noteworthy to mention that the hackathon is conducted in SKCET for the third consecutive time.

- **Encouraging all faculty members to pursue NPTEL/MOOC**

Target based faculty appraisal system is implemented to monitor the progress of the teaching learning process (TLP) to motivate all faculty members to pursue NPTEL/MOOC. These technical courses undertaken by students and faculty have helped SKCET attain 11th in National level.

- **Promoting electives/courses offered by Industries**

MoU with TCS has paved way for a new course namely B.Tech computer science and business systems and this will enable a batch of students to study the courses proposed by TCS. The students shall be recruited by TCS after successfully completing the B.Tech Degree programme.

Virtusa powered M.Tech Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) will enable the student industry ready and the students will specialize in full stack programming.

Virtusa agreed to set-up a centre of excellence to train and recruit BE CSE, ECE, EEE and B.Tech IT students.

Zoho has inked MoU with SKCET to provide Zoho creator certified associate training to our students

- **Promoting faculty to publish papers in Scopus/Web of Science Journals and reviewing their performance periodically**

A total of 413 papers were published in the international Scopus / WoS journals for the academic year 2018-2019. This is in addition to the UGC index of journals

2. Academic calendar

Academic calendar should be published before June 2019. The calendar should include the details of administrative incharges.

3. Plan of events

In order to ensure the industry institute interaction and train the students with recent technologies, seminars and workshops are organized with the support of the industries. The list of industries and suitable resource persons are to be identified. The faculty development program and workshop on patent filing shall also be considered in the list of events.

4. Curriculum Revision

The syllabus of 2019-2020 academic year must be finalized before June 2019 after board of studied meeting.

5. Academic and administrative audit

An academic and administrative audit shall be conducted in the month of May to ensure the standards in the teaching learning process.

6. Faculty review

A faculty review shall be conducted to evaluate the performance of a faculty in the teaching, journal publications and obtaining research grants. Non performing faculty may be motivated for better results.

4. Overall targets for next year

Overall targets for the academic year 2019-2020 were discussed. The committee members insisted to apply for NBA Accreditation for civil and EEE program courses. They also encouraged the institution to obtain A+ grade in NAAC 2020.
