PART A: ACTION TAKEN ON THE MINUTES

1. Academic calendar

The academic calendar for 2023-2024 was released and distributed to students and faculty members, along with the contact information of administrative incharges.

2. Plan of events

The management has approved a series of Seminars, Conferences, and Faculty Development Programs for the academic year 2023-2024. These programs aim to educate students about the latest technological advancements and enhance the knowledge of the faculty. A list of resource persons from prominent industries and academia has been finalized for these events.

3. Curriculum Revision

After several brainstorming sessions, the board of studies meeting, which included academic experts, industry professionals, and alumni, finalized the R2023 curriculum. The curriculum for the upcoming academic year, 2023-2024, was revised to incorporate the specific needs and requirements of the industry.

4. NAAC Accreditation

Following the committee members' recommendation, the institution is making preparations to submit the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) in July and subsequently apply for accreditation from the NAAC. The institution is actively working towards achieving the highest NAAC grade of A++.

PART B: DISCISSIONS AND DELEBERATIONS

1. TARGETS AND PLANS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024

Based on the discussion of the IQAC meeting, the following targets are set for the academic year 2023-24.

- To organize education summits to facilitate collaboration, share best practices, and address challenges and opportunities in the field of education at a global level.
- To obtain NBA Accreditation for BE CSE,IT,ECE, MECH and MBA Programmes
- Encourage students to participate in Sports, Yoga and Cultural activities for their overall development and well-being
- To train the faculty members through professional organization and enable them to transfer the knowledge to the students.
- Inculcate social awareness among students through tree plantation, blood donation and awareness rally.

2.MOOC Courses

The committee members emphasized the importance of the institution encouraging greater participation from faculty and students in MOOCs, such as those provided by NPTEL and Coursera. They also commended the institution for implementing the courses as mandatory subjects in the previous year. Furthermore, it was recommended that faculty members should enroll in at least one MOOC/NPTEL course per academic year.

3. Identification of professional organization for training the faculty members

Committee members recommended extensive research to identify professional organizations that are known for their expertise in faculty development and training with a strong track record, positive reputation, and a focus on the specific thrust areas such as Web development, Advanced Java, DBMS, Cloud computing, Data structures using C++ and Application development.

4.AICTE Curriculum implementation

The committee members inquired about the revision and enforcement of the program. The principal assured the committee members that the curriculum has been revised to meet industry standards, and faculty members have been trained in the new curriculum through faculty development programs.









9. Village Progress Assessment
