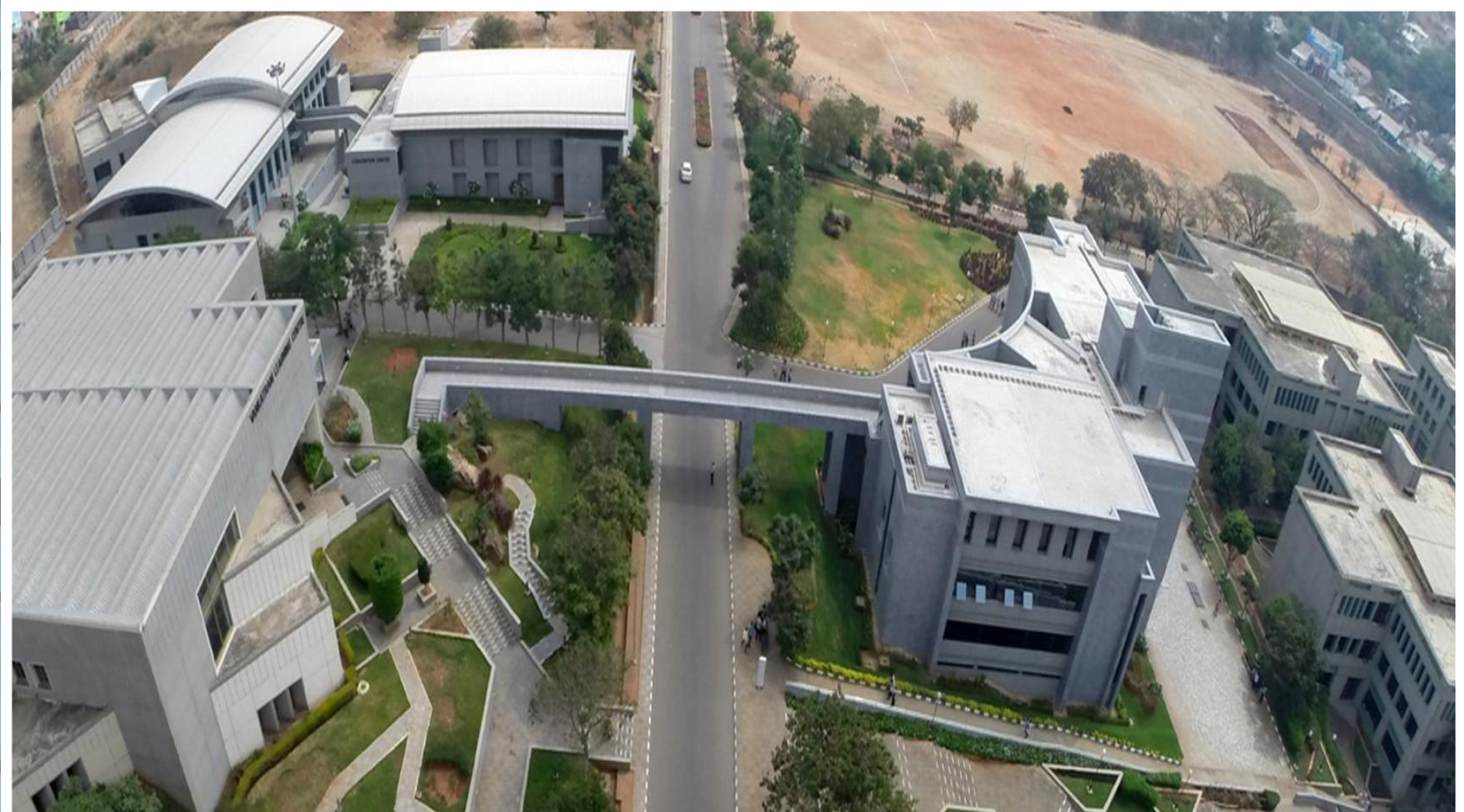

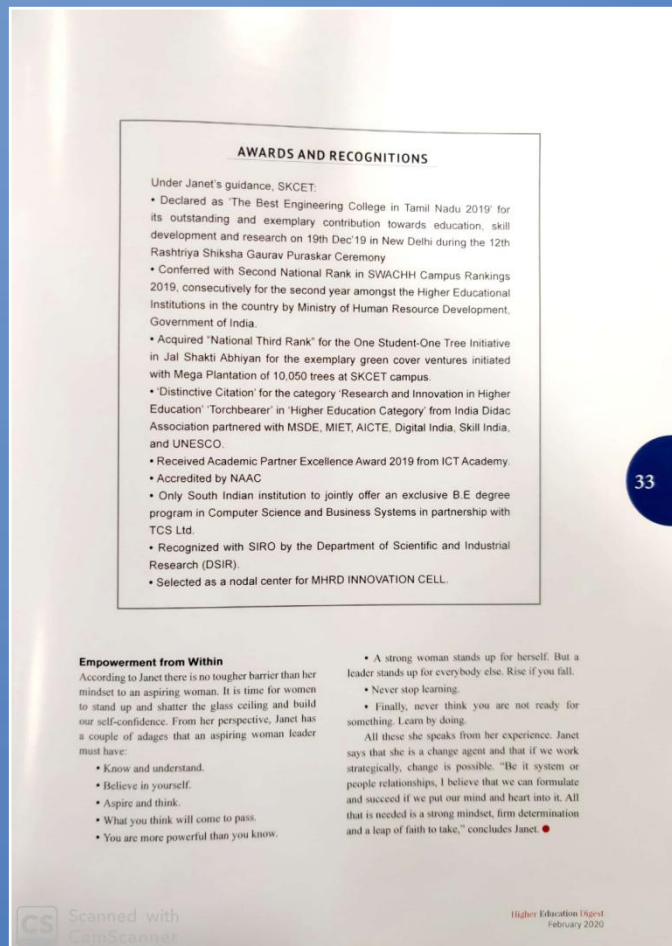

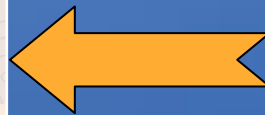

An online **project review-phase II** was conducted for the II year students of School of Management. The project coordinators reviewed the project status and gave their suggestions for further improvement.

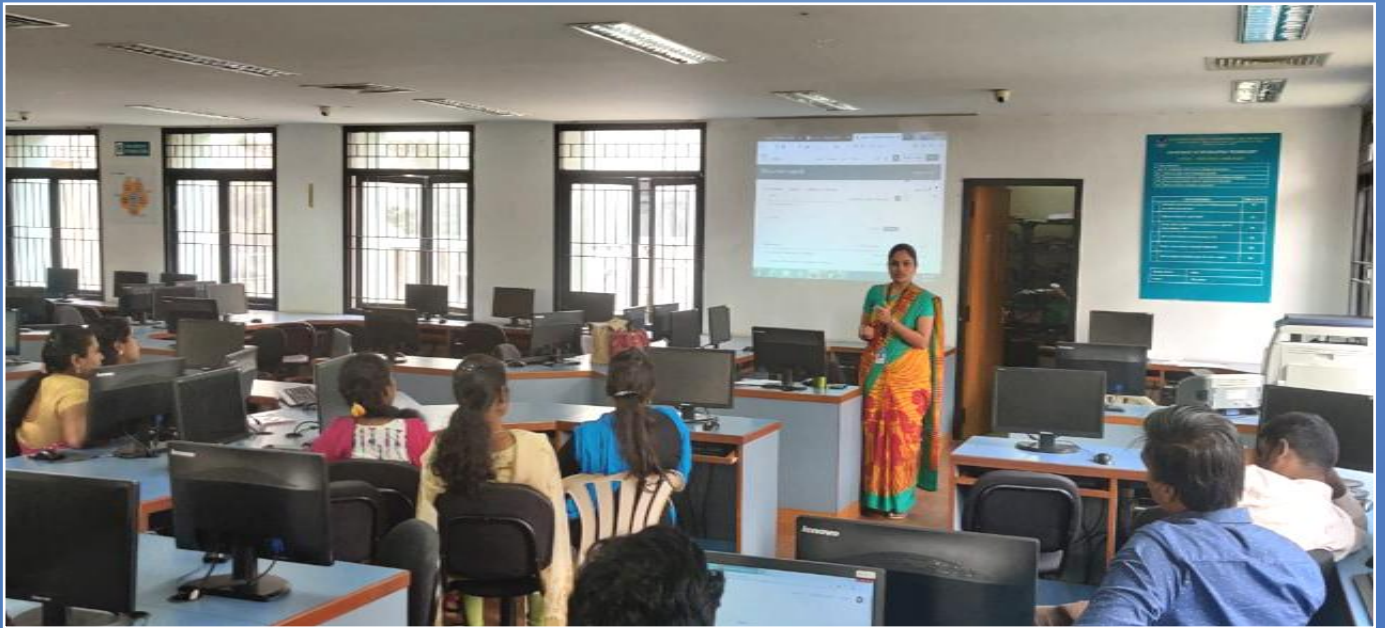


## CSE – DEPARTMENT MEETING

## IT – FACULTY SEMINAR

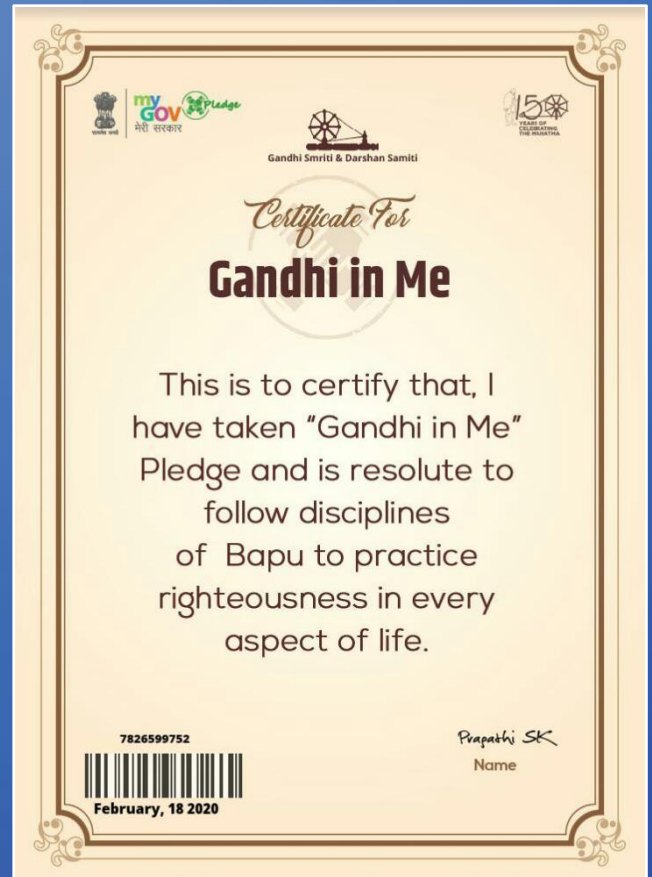

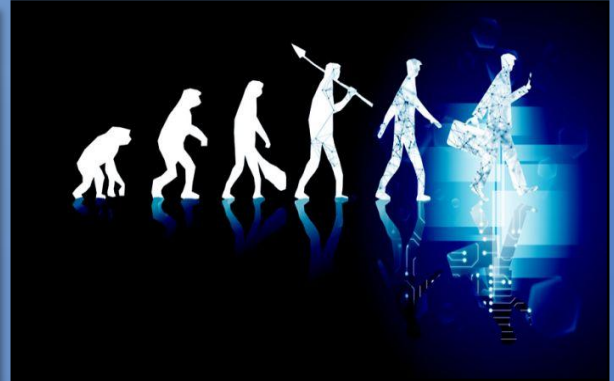

## NEW WORD OF THE DAY: SEA CHANGE



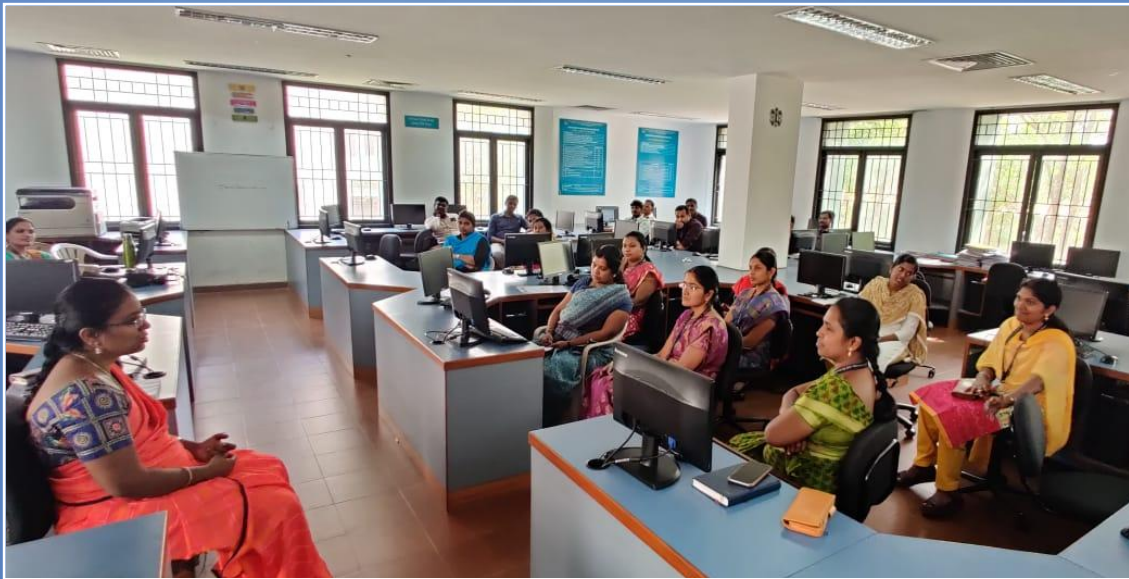
**MEANING:** A profound or notable transformation.

**Dr. S. Sophia**, Head of the Department, ECE convened a meeting with the department members regarding the action plans to be implemented for the academic and R&D related work.



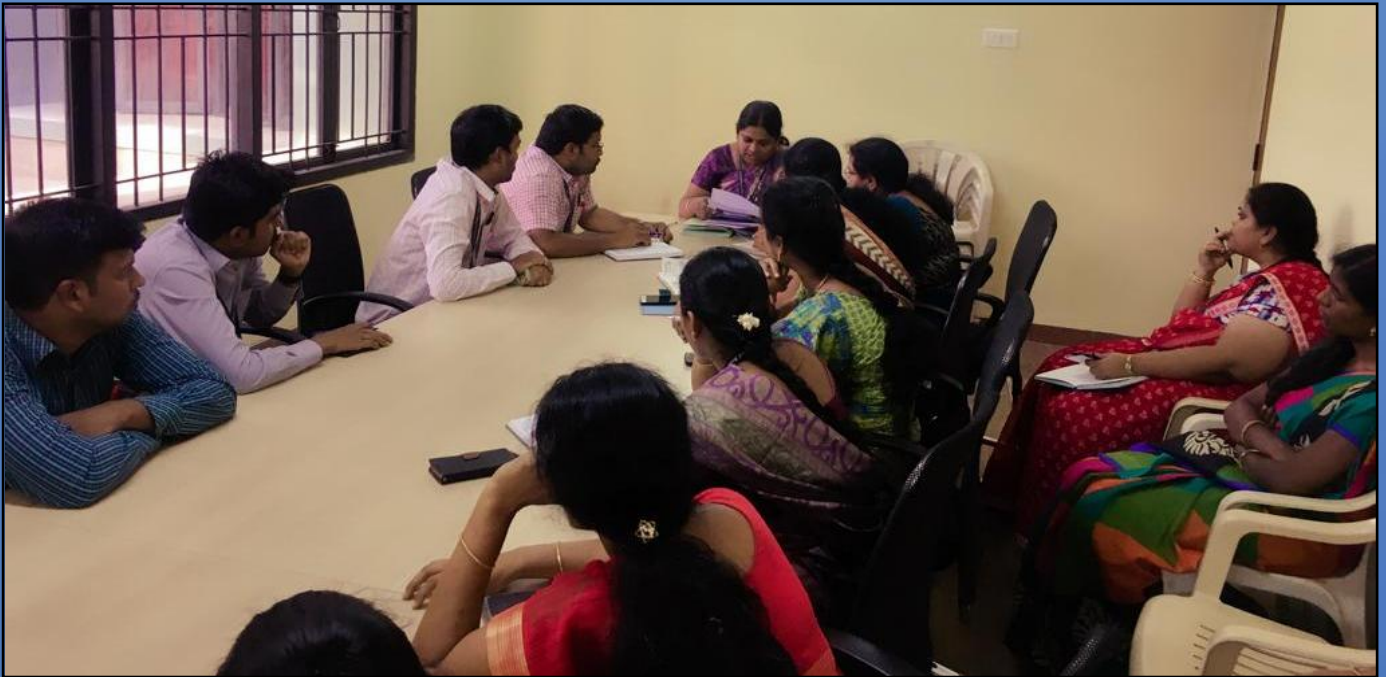

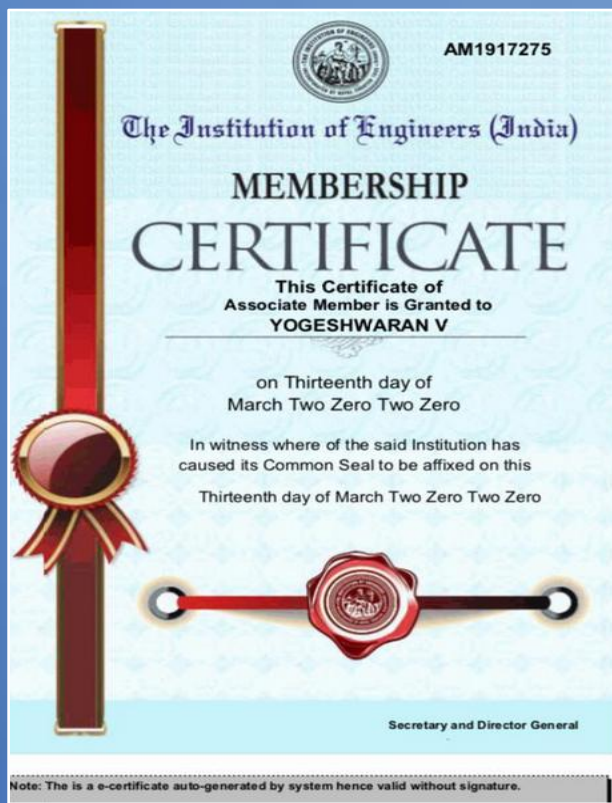

## CELEBRATING WOMEN ACHIEVERS OF INDIA



### **Mann Kaur, a centenarian sprinter**

She was recently honoured the 'Nari Shakti Puraskar 2020', the country's highest civilian honour for women by Hon'ble President Ram Nath Kovind on March 8, on the occasion of International Women's Day.

Known as the "Miracle from Chandigarh", 103-year-old Mann Kaur started running when she was 91 years old. She is the oldest person in the world to walk along the top of Auckland's Sky Tower in 2017. The 103-year-old lady has won more than 20 medals in World Masters Games and America Masters Game (Gold), 100 m World Masters Games in New Zealand in 2017 (100m and 200 m) at National Level, Gold (100 m and 200m) at Worlds Master Championship at USA in 2013.

Mann Kaur is also associated with the Fit India Movement which was launched by PM Modi ji last year as a way to encourage people to remain healthy and fit through more physical exercise. Despite her osteoporosis, she has broken multiple world records and won more medals with her determination to succeed.

### REMEMBERING INDIA'S FEMALE 'SPACE STAR'

**Kalpana Chawla** the first Indian born American Astronaut who touched the sky was on **March 17<sup>th</sup> 1992**. Kalpana Chawla is a role model for not just women around the world, but anyone that dreamt of being an astronaut. She went to space on two missions as a NASA astronaut - both on space shuttle Columbia.

#### 6 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT KALPANA CHAWLA: THE FIRST INDIAN WOMAN IN SPACE

- Kalpana Chawla completed her early education in Punjab.
- She became a naturalized US citizen in April 1991 and applied for the NASA Astronaut Corps.
- In 1997, she became the first Indian-born woman and the second Indian person to fly in space.
- Her second flight was also her last.
- She was posthumously honored with the Congressional Space Medal of Honor, NASA Space Flight Medal and NASA Distinguished Service Medal.
- Kalpana Chawla logged 30 days, 14 hours, and 54 minutes in space over the course of her two missions.

Kalpana will always be remembered for her incredible journey from Karnal, where she was born, to NASA, where she fulfilled her dream of reaching the stars.
