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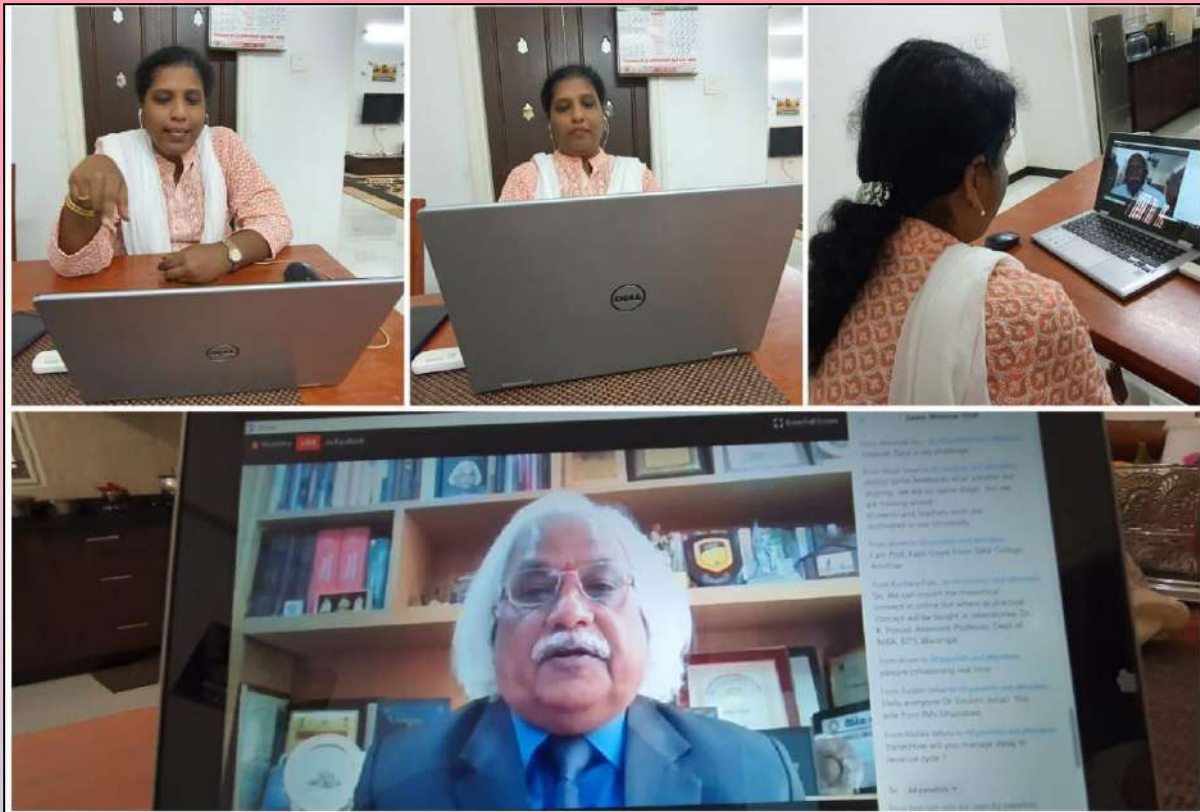

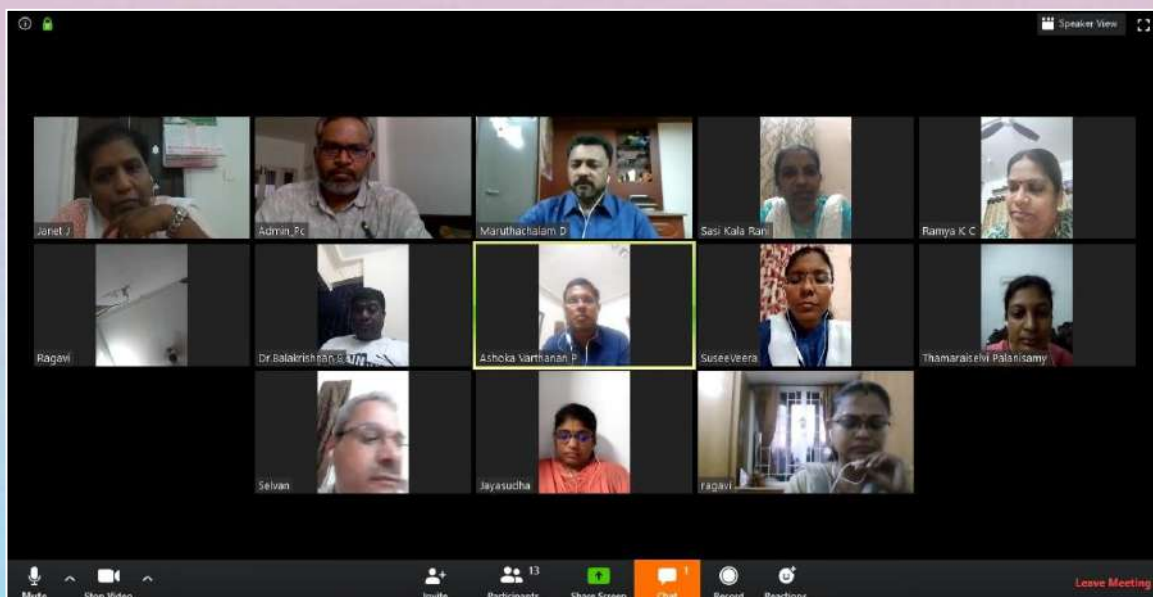

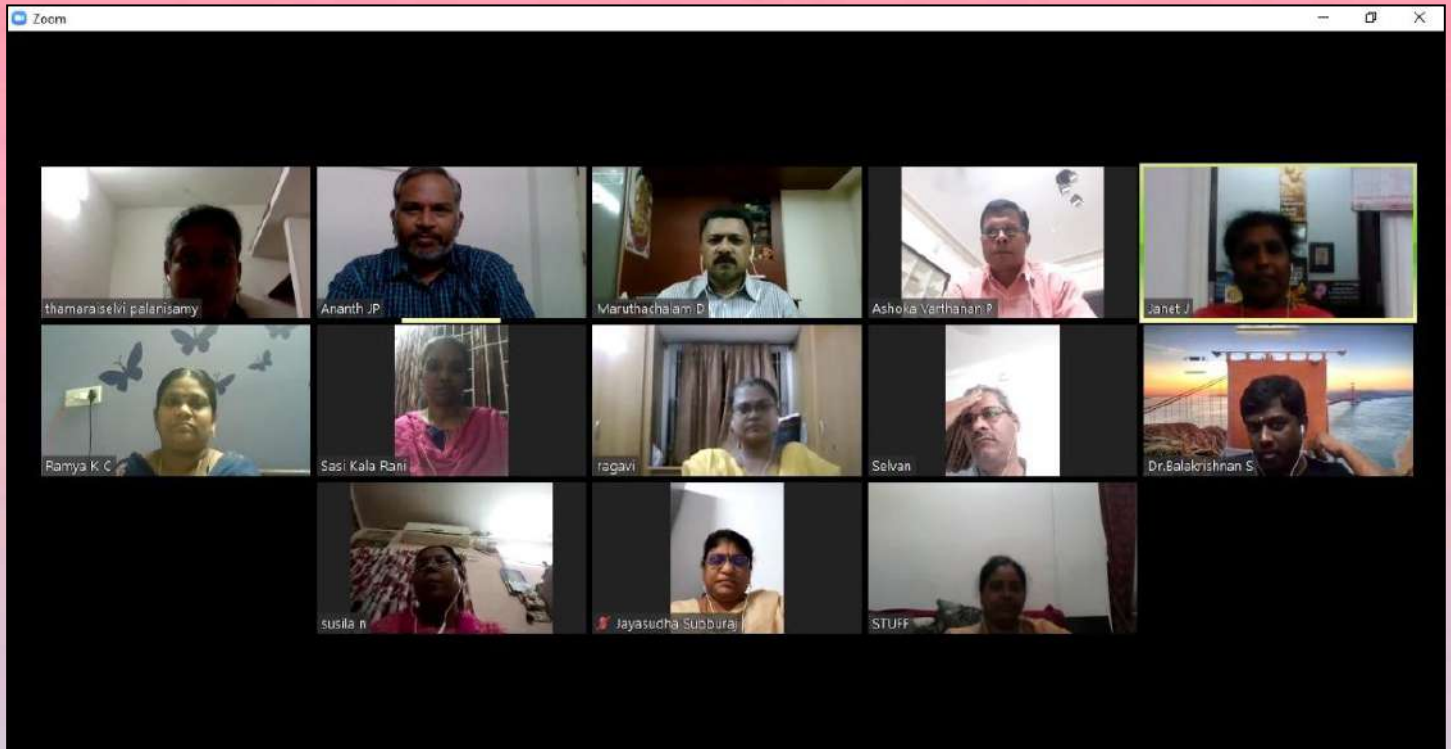


PRINCIPAL PLENUM #1

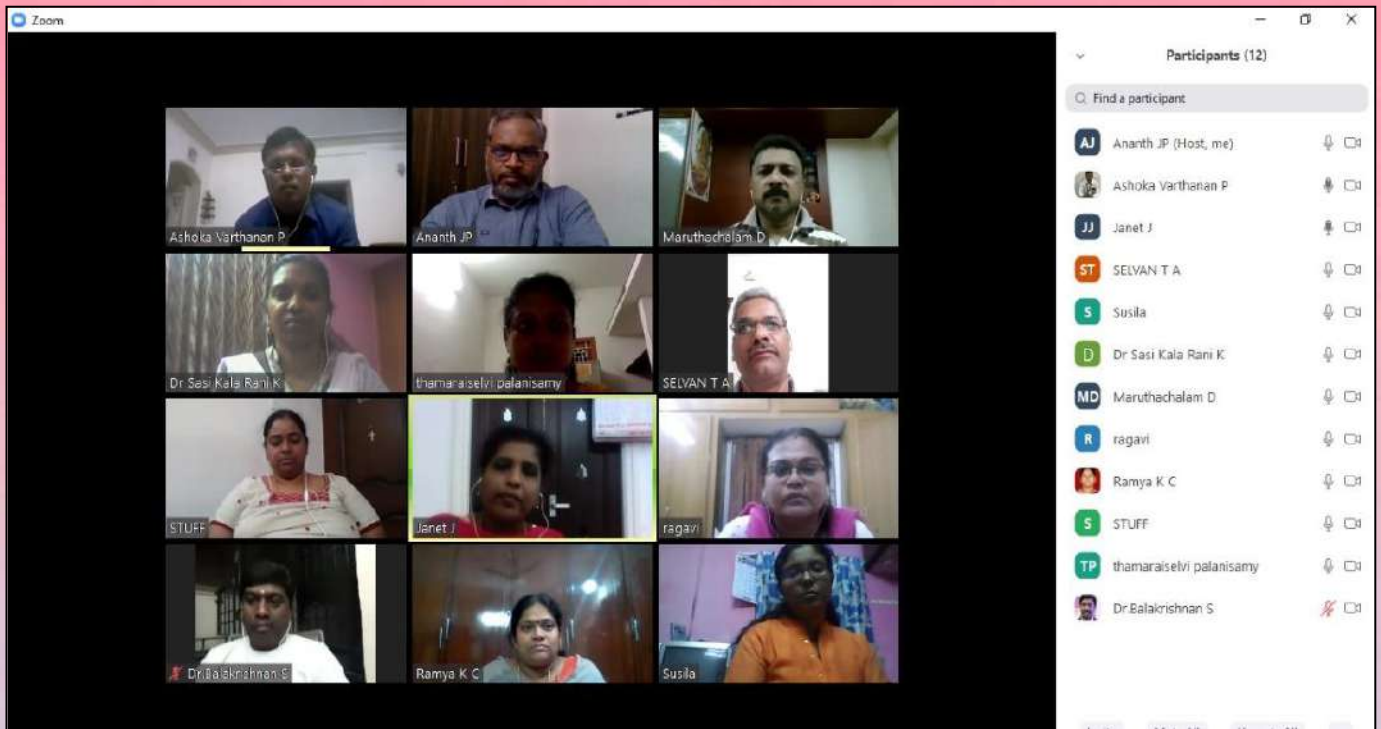
Adoptable Best practices

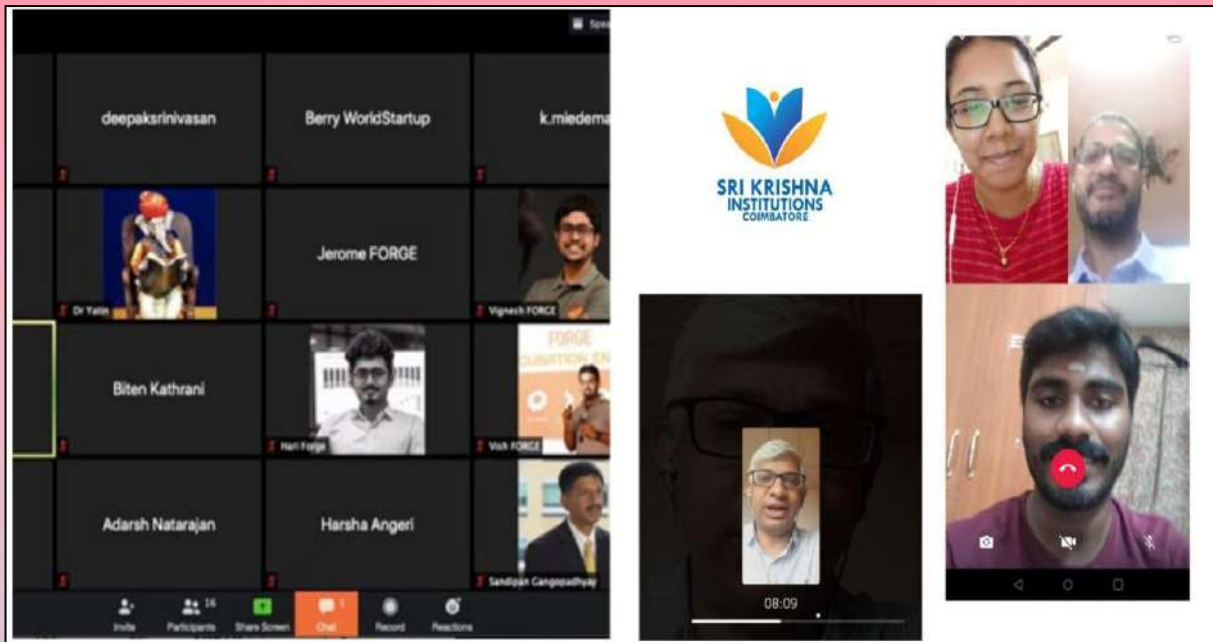
PLA BASED 'Y' AND 'T' VENTILATOR SPLITTERS AND FACE MASK TO FIGHT AGAINST COVID'19

8.1 Introduction

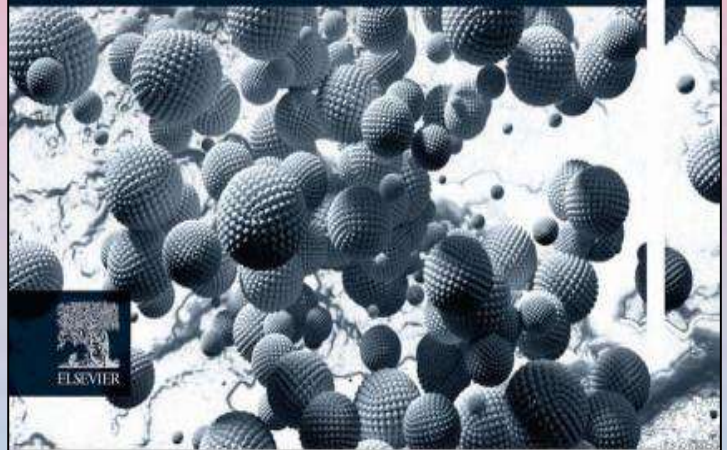
Air pollution is a grave danger to our planet. More than half of the world population has no access to clean fuels or technologies (e.g., stoves, lamps), and the very basic need for survival, that is, pure air we breathe is growing dangerously polluted. The death toll has been estimated as 7 million people every year due to inhalation of highly contaminated air. Automobiles and industrial activities are the major sources for the emission of gas pollutants. The pollutant standard index (PSI) is an indicator and measure of pollution. The PSI value varies from 0 to 500. The concentration of five major air pollutants including particulate matters (PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5}), sulfur oxides (SO₂), nitrogen oxides (NO₂), carbon monoxide (CO), and ozone (O₃) in the air are taken into account for the calculation of PSI [1]. The presence of toxic contaminants in air affects the lifestyle of human. Intake of the contaminated air causes many health issues such as malignant tumors, renal failures, metabolic aberrations and central nervous system disorders. The level of contaminants in air is mainly ascribed to the intensification of industrial activities and the increase of automobiles. In addition to this, indoor air pollution is one of the significant issues as most of the people spend ~80% of their time in indoor environment (e.g., school, office, universities, theaters, shopping complex, etc.). The efficiency and productivity of human can be improved through the intake of the good indoor air. The air pollutants can be classified as primary and secondary pollutants. Primary air pollutants include the sources that are directly emitted into the atmosphere such as CO, CO₂, SO₂, NO_x, PM₁₀, PM_{2.5}, and volatile organic compounds (VOCs). These pollutants are released through the burning of fossil fuels, gasoline products, wood, coal, and natural gas. Secondary air pollutants are not directly emitted from the source;
