3. **The Context:**

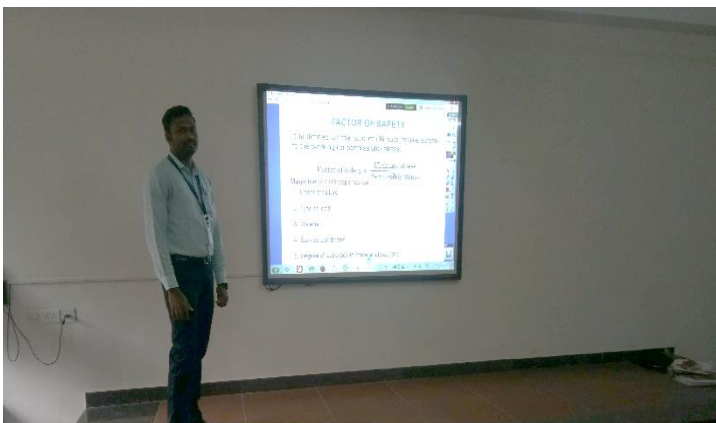

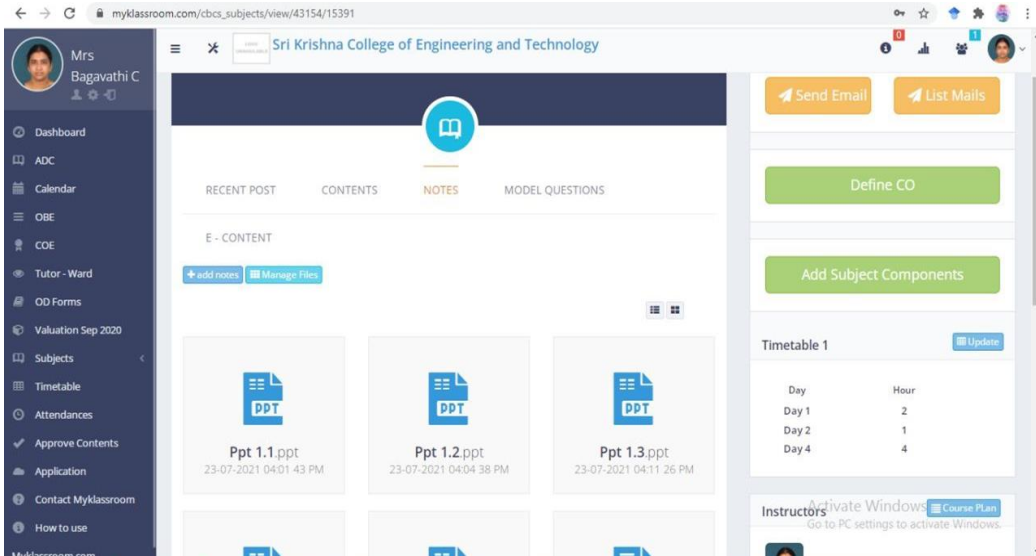
Student Presentation through Smartboard



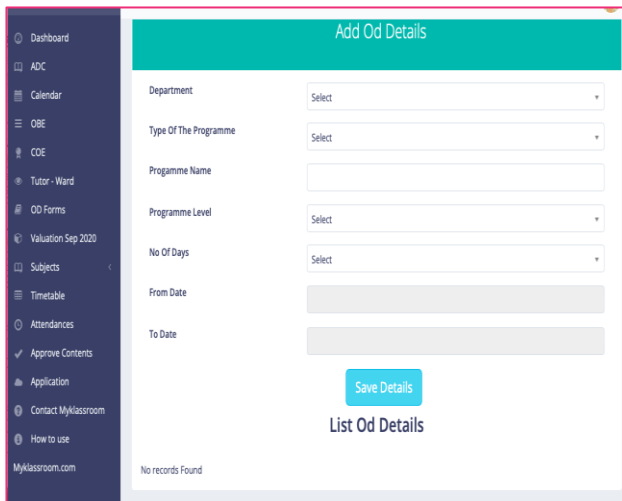

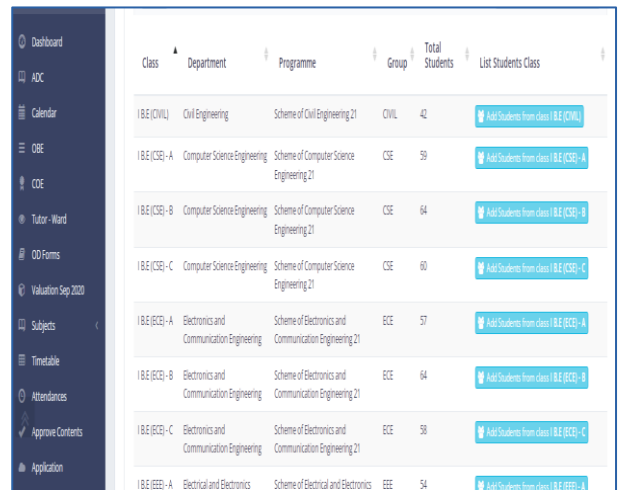
