POLICY

Institution has initiated the Gender Audit and Measures for the promotion of Gender Equity during the last five years. The Institution prioritizes the well-being of its students and established an environment that eliminates mental and physical discrimination and harassment. This comprehensive approach reflects the institutions commitment to addressing gender disparities, fostering gender-sensitive policies and practices and promoting a culture of equality, respect and dignity for all members of the community. The Women Empowerment Cell is effectively functioning towards empowering women and provides a safe environment, promoting gender equality and working towards the elimination of discrimination and violence against women. This cell stands to facilitate women's empowerment through guest lectures, seminars etc. For gender equality and justice in all its interventions and practices, an Internal Compliance Committee (ICC) is established, following government guidelines and aligning with the Sustainable Development Goal 5 of the UN, which addresses gender equality. The cell is responsible for looking into complaints filed by students and staff about any grievance. The institution also maintains a robust Anti-Ragging, Grievance Redressal, Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell (PoSH). Committed to student and staff well-being, it ensures a safe environment, addresses grievances promptly, and upholds internal compliance standards, fostering a positive and secure educational atmosphere. The institution has integrated gender related courses into the curriculum to raise the awareness about the intersection nature of gender and its implications for individuals, communities and societies. Recruitment practices is a critical component of the Institution's gender equity initiatives. The institution strives to ensure equal opportunities for individuals of all genders in faculty and staff positions. More than 50% of the total faculty strength at the Institution comprises of female faculty members. They hold diverse positions, including Principal, Deans, Heads of Departments and members of various Statutory and Non-statutory committees. The Institutions'



infrastructure planning also incorporates gender-sensitive considerations to create a safe and inclusive environment for all. This includes the provision of gender-neutral facilities, adequate lighting, and installation of CCTV cameras in various places inside college campus and in college buses and security guards to ensure the well-being and security of all members of the campus community. Common rooms are established for both men and women to relax themselves when they feel tired. The institution provides support services and resources to address the unique needs and challenges faced by individuals of all genders. This includes offering parental leave policies and other family-friendly initiatives to support work-life balance of faculty, staff and students. Prioritizing the safety and security of female students, silambam classes have been arranged in the evenings within the hostel premises to equip girls with self- defence skills. Furthermore, the Institution has introduced measures to enhance gender sensitivity in co-curricular activities. Events, seminars, and workshops are organized to raise awareness about gender issues, promote a culture of respect and equality, and empower students with the knowledge and skills to contribute positively to gender equity. Such initiatives not only educate the student body but also contribute to the creation of a campus culture that values diversity and inclusive.



In commemoration of the World Diabetes Day, Department of Science and Humanities in association with Women Empowerment Cell organized a special awareness talk on Diabetes - the global health issue and what has to be done collectively for better prevention, diagnosis and management of the condition. Dr. Rajasekaran, Diabetes, Heart Specialist & General Physician, Priya Clinic & Diabetic Centre, Coimbatore was the Chief Guest of the day. This event raised an awareness about the impact of diabetes on the health of people and to highlight the opportunities to strengthen the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of diabetes. To incorporate physical activity into daily routines helps to control weight and improves insulin sensitivity and aim for at least 150 minutes of moderate-intensity exercise per week.

Students demonstrated their culinary skills by preparing a variety of delicious and nutritious dishes suitable for individuals with diabetes. 


