
A **Plantation drive** was also organised within the campus in which **more than 200 saplings** were planted to commemorate the Jal Diwas initiative.

LAKE CLEANING:

Saving water is of prime importance in today's world. To sensitize the students regarding this, SKCETians in association with **Kovai Kulangal Padhukappu Amaippu**, visited the **Vellalore Lake area** and carried cleanliness activities.

THE MIYAWAKI METHOD:

Miyawaki is a technique pioneered by Japanese botanist Akira Miyawaki, which helps build dense, native forests. The approach is supposed to ensure that plant growth is 10 times faster and the resulting plantation is 30 times denser than usual.

The students were enlightened on the method and the various procedures to do the same by the people from the organisation, who are pioneers in cleaning water bodies in all surrounding areas.

We were also informed about the 70 edible species that were planted in and around.





To prevent further encroachment, several cleaning activities were taken up to bring in a cleanr, greener environment around the lake.







TREE PLANTATION:

Trees serve as a source for various needs in our day-to-day lives. As part of the Jal Shakti Abhiyan to bring in more water, and adopting the Miyawiki method, several plants were planted in and around the area.
